WILKESBARRE, Pa., March 28.—Sixteen dwellings were wrecked at Hamtown, a small mining village near here, by a cavein at the abandoned No. 8 colliery of the Pennsylvania Coal company. The broken water main is flooding the mine, and the cave is extending. Huge fissures have appeared in the streets of the town and many houses are in danger. Residents near the mine are removing to places of safety.
