

TWO SISTERS DROWN IN QUARRY

Girl's Heroic Effort to Save Child Results in Death.

Milwaukee, Wis., May 23.—Fourteen-year-old Lillie Seuberth gave her life Sunday afternoon in a vain attempt to save her 8-year-old sister Lydia from drowning. The little one lost her footing on the bank of an old stone quarry and fell into the water. Her older sister jumped into the pond after her and both were drowned. The children were fishing in the quarry when the accident happened. Many people have been drowned in the same quarry and the authorities are trying to have it filled up.
