

BOY DROWNS IN QUARRY

Cave-in of Bank on Which he Was Sitting Results in Death.

Poultney, July 22.—Arnold Edwards the 12 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Edwards of North Poultney was drowned this afternoon about 3 o'clock by falling into an old pit filled with water at the William E. Lloyd quarry.

Young Richards was sitting alone on the bank, which apparently caved in, throwing him into the water. He was missed later and a search at the quarry pit resulted in the finding of his body in several feet of water.

The boy's mother was attending a funeral at Fair Haven when she was notified of the accident and returned at once to her home here, where the body was taken.
