

FIVE KILLED IN ABANDONED MINE

McALESTER, Okla., June 26.—

Five persons lost their lives near Hantington, Ark., yesterday afternoon when two men sought to save the three children who had wandered to the mouth of the mines closed since the strike, it was learned today. The children were overcome by Black Damp gas, as were the men who sought to rescue them. Names of the victims have not been learned. The mine is the property of the Central Coal & Coke Co. W. W. Fleming, of the mine rescue station was called to the scene.
