THREE KILLED IN ABANDONED MINE

HIMLERVILLE, Ky., Nov. 28.—Richard H. Williams, Charles H. Beidenmiller and C. D. Schlegel, president, chief engineer and superintendent, respectively, of the Glogora Coal Company, were instantly killed in a mine explosion which rocked the countryside near here today.

The men were on an inspection tour of an abandoned mine with a view of gathering data concerning the reopening of the mine when the blast let go. It is thought the deadly "black damp" in the mine became ignited and caused the explosion.
