Man Dead in Abandoned Mine

N.S.)—Oxygen converted into carbon monoxide gas by a gasoline burner used to operate whiskey still in an abandoned mine near here caused the death of John Manning, a young farmer, authorities found today, when they raided the distillery. Two companions found unconscious were rushed to a hospital. They are expected to recover.
