

YOUTH DROWNS QUARRY POOL

BLOOMINGTON, Ind., July 22.—(AP)—Leaving five younger companions wading in a pool to bathe in the cooler, cleaner waters of a stone quarry southwest of here, resulted in the drowning of Charles Epperson, 17, today.

Epperson, who was unable to swim, called frantically for help soon after leaving his companions. Opal Wayne Hostler, 13, was first to reach the quarry hole and saw Epperson go under for the last time. None of the five was able to swim.

Benton Cook, 18-year-old Bloomington high school athlete, found the body in 20 feet of water after seven dives.
