

Black Damp Overcomes Two in Abandoned Mine

UNIONTOWN, Pa., Sept. 21—

Found unconscious in an abandoned coal mine at Stonerville, near Ohio Pyle, William Morrison, 21, and John Michaels, 30, were dragged to safety by Robert Morrison, the former's brother, today.

The men were overcome by black damp 200 feet in the mine, where they had gone in search of parts to repair a wagon. Robert Morrison went to look for them when they failed to reappear.
