

Boy Killed Playing In Abandoned Mine

One boy was killed and several others narrowly escaped a similar fate today while they were playing in an abandoned mine at Dupont, near Scranton. Frank Koza, 12-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Peter Koza, Dupont, was walking some distance ahead of several other boys in the old workings when the roof caved in and crushed him.

Koza's companions rushed out through the opening and gave the alarm. A rescue squad labored more than an hour before they recovered the crushed body.
