

School Boy Killed In Abandoned Mine

Stanley, N.C., Feb. 4 (AP)—A 100-year-old abandoned iron mine caved in near here yesterday, killing one boy and hurting three. They were among 25 Stanley High School students on an educational tour. A road crew working nearby rushed to the scene and dug frantically for 30 minutes before rescuing the four boys who had entered an underground shaft.

Boyd Ledford, 12, died in a hospital. Witnesses said they believed the weight of other members of the party walking over the area caused the cavein.
