Identity of Polozeck's hunting companion could not be learned in Corpus Christi this morning. A group of George West hunters have been in the area several days.

Roger Umphries this morning telephoned his family at George tice of Corpus Christi pleaded West and said the group is returning to George West today. Umphries did not know who was hunting with Polozeck yesterday.

A doctor who examined Polozeck said he died of multiple injuries.
