

Union County Men Drown As Boat Upsets

MARYSVILLE, O. — (AP) — Two Union County men drowned early Friday when their boat overturned in an abandoned quarry 12 miles west of Milford Center in Union County.

The victims were identified as John L. Houser, 59, and William B. Goff, 45, both of near Milford Center. They were on a frog hunting expedition.

A third member of the party, Duke Gregg, 45, also of near Milford Center, managed to stay with the overturned boat and eventually made it to shore.

Gregg told deputies the boat overturned about 1 a.m. while they were attempting to capture some frogs. He said he tried to find his companions in the water but could not see them in the darkness.
