A South Junior High School student drowned yesterday in an abandoned quarry in Monroe County.

Jerry Lee Perry, 14-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Virgil Perry, 2330 Sylvania Ave., was looking for arrow heads when he fell into the barite quarry just off the Sweetwater-Vonore Rd.

Young Perry was a member of the Island Home Assembly of God Church and was in the eighth grade at South.

Besides his parents, he leaves brothers, Charley Eugene, Roscoe, and Billy Perry; and sister, Sharon Perry.

Services will be at 2:30 p. m. tomorrow at Island Home Assembly of God with burial in Woodlawn Cemetery. The family will receive friends 7-9 tonight at Berry's.
