Julian Resident Drowns In Pond

A 28-y e a r -o l d Julian man drowned this morning in a pond at an abandoned rock quarry about 15 miles south of Greensboro on N. C. Highway 61.

The victim was identified by sheriff's deputies as Larry Dale McLintock. The body was taken to Moses Cone Hospital shortly after 7:30 a.m.

According to sheriff's deputies, they received a call about 5 a.m. and an ambulance and divers were dispatched to the scene. The divers worked for almost two hours before finding the body in about 15 feet of water.

Deputies said McLintock and several other persons went to the pond shortly after midnight when they got off work. An investigator said that the victim and his companions were apparently having a party when Mc-Lintock jumped into the water from some rocks. Witnesses said he swam out into the darkness but didn't return. McLintock's companions drove about three miles where they located a telephone and contacted authorities.
