

Boy, 17, drowns in quarry

A 17-year-old Youngstown boy drowned in the water of an abandoned quarry in Mahoning Twp. about four miles east of the Pennsylvania-Ohio line near Route 422 sometime late last night, according to Lawrence County Coroner Howard H. Reynolds.

Reynolds, who aided Union Twp. firemen in the recovery of the body, pronounced Victor Bugno of Shehy St., Youngstown, dead at the scene at 3:50 this morning as a result of drowning.

The boy along with some other young people decided to go for a swim in the water of the abandoned quarry sometime late last night when the drowning occurred, Reynolds reported.

The boy's body was recovered by the firemen at 3:50 this morning after a brief search. The parents were notified and the body is expected to be taken to Youngstown later today, according to the coroner's report.
