Man Drowns In Westminster

WESTMINSTER — James M. Latham, 31, of Westminster, drowned Saturday while swimming in the "old quarry pond," the Vermont State Police reported.

Police said that Latham was swimming with some campanions at 3 a.m. when he went under. He was pulled out by his companions and taken to Rockingham Memorial Hospital, where he was pronounced dead on arrival, police said.

Latham was born in Ipswich, Mass., Feb. 13, 1945, son of John T. and Ruth (Norman) Latham. He attended school in Walpole, N.H. He was a self-employed

printer and was a member of the BPOE Lodge 1619 in Bellows Falls.

Mr. Latham is survived by his mother, Mrs. Ruth (Norman) (Latham) Boston of Marlborough, N.H.; a son, James McKellip Latham of Walpole; three brothers, John and Richard of Walpole, and Thomas of Danbury, Conn.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 2 p.m. in the First Congregational Church in Walpole. The Rev. Raymond Fenner will officiate. There will be no calling hours.
