

Louisville Man Drowns in Quarry

CHARLESTOWN, Ind. (UPI) — John F. Harris, 53, Louisville, drowned in a Clark County stone quarry during a weekend outing with friends after leaving them in one area while he was swimming in another.

Indiana State Police said Harris' body was recovered from the water at the Charlestown quarry along Indiana 62 east of Charleston Saturday afternoon.

Investigators said Harris, who had been drinking, and seven friends came to the quarry but he decided to swim by himself. The body was found by the friends floating face down about an hour later.
