

Neenah man, 20, drowns in quarry

GREENVILLE — A 20-year-old Neenah man drowned Thursday afternoon while swimming in a quarry here west of Island Road about two miles south of U.S. 10.

The body of Michael E. Sedo, 210 Webster St., Neenah, was recovered about 5½ hours after he disappeared while swimming with his step-brother Richard L. Becker, 28, of Menasha.

Outagamie County Deputy Coroner William Knutson said Sedo died as a result of accidental drowning. He is the son of Eugene Sedo of Neenah and Norine Huffman of Lakewood.

Outagamie County authorities were called to the quarry about two miles southeast of Medina about 2:45 p.m. Thursday.

Becker told authorities he and Sedo were working on a car in Neenah early in the afternoon and then drove to the quarry where an estimated 50 other young people were swimming. After their arrival, Becker said, they washed their hair and then began swimming from the south shore to the north shore, a distance of about 100 yards.

While he was swimming, Becker said he looked back a couple times
