Man Drowns In Rock Quarry

A 38-year-old Winston-Salem man drowned early this morning in an abandoned rock quarry on Rosann Drive near old Lexington Road.

Authorities said Jimmy Lane Drye of 2035 Milford Street had apparently gone to the quarry with several friends sometime before 3 a.m. and had jumped of a 25foot cliff into the water.

His friends called the Forsyth County Sheriff's Department when Drye did not come to the surface, Chief Larry McLean with the Forsyth Water Rescue Team said this morning.

He was dead when divers pulled him from the water shortly before 3:30 a.m, Mc-Lean said.
