

Kansas City man drowns at quarry

Jefferson City—A 20-year-old Lincoln University student from Kansas City drowned Friday after apparently suffering leg cramps while swimming in an abandoned rock quarry near the school, police said.

Lt. Carl Monteer of the Jefferson City Police Department said a body pulled from the quarry about 7:30 p.m. Friday was identified as that of Eddie Leon Page of 2945 Indiana Ave.

Lt. Monteer said Mr. Page had been swimming with friends when he apparently started cramping. He said a friend of the victim told police that Mr. Page bobbed in the water and shouted, "I can't kick my legs," before he went under.
