

# Vermonters drown in quarry

WINDSOR (AP) — A former Windsor man and a veteran rescue worker trying to save him drowned last week in a Tennessee quarry.

Aaron Leigh Creighton, 21, a 1993 Windsor High School graduate who moved with his family to Tennessee soon after graduation, apparently drowned in the 200-foot-deep South Knoxville quarry after being bitten by a snake.

Creighton and four friends went to the quarry to swim at about 4 a.m. on Aug. 24, according to a report in The

Knoxville News-Sentinel.

Creighton dove into the quarry and began thrashing in the water, went under three times, then disappeared, the paper reported.

Police said Creighton had "marks on his chest consistent with snake bites," but that Creighton died of drowning.
