Vermonter drowns in quarry

WINDSOR (AP) - A former Windsor man and a veteran rescue worker trying to save him drowned last week in a Ten-

nessee quarry.

Aaron Leigh Creighton, 21, a 1993 Windsor High graduate who moved with his family to Tennessee soon after graduation, apparently drowned 200-foot-deep Knoxville quarry after being bitten by a snake.

Creighton and four friends went to the quarry to swim at about 4 a.m. on Aug. 24, according report The to a

Knoxville News-Sentinel.

Creighton dove into the quarry and began thrashing in the water, went under three times, then disappeared, the paper reported.

Police said Creighton had "marks on his chest consistent with snake bites," but that Creighton died of drowning.
