Teen, man drown in separate weekend incidents

The bodies of two Kentucky drowning victims were recovered over the weekend.

Yesterday, after searching for two days, rescue workers found the body of Victor Phillips Jr., 15, of Tiline in Livingston County.

Victor and a family member were swimming at the Three Rivers rock quarry on the Cumberland River Friday afternoon when Victor hit his head on a moored barge and went under it, officials said.

On Saturday, a Madisonville man

drowned after diving into a strip pit on abandoned mine property, Kentucky State Police said. Marvin E. Parrish, 37, was pronounced dead at the scene by the Muhlenberg County coroner. Police said Parrish dove off a 50-foot ledge and did not resurface after he entered the water.
