Pontiac man, 20, drowns in stone quarry

Terence Lee Reid-Lance, 20, of Pontiac drowned Wednesday night while swimming with friends in a Monroe stone quarry, the Monroe County Sheriff's Office said.

Reid-Lance disappeared underwater about 9:25 p.m. at the France Stone quarry, the sheriff's office said. Rescuers found his body about 25 feet from the quarry's edge in water that is 35 feet deep. Foul play is not suspected.
