## Bolingbrook teen drowns in quarry

Bolingbrook High School senior Javier Vera died in August when he drowned in an area quarry.

The 17-year-old was remembered as “a well-liked student, with a good academic record and an excellent attendance record, on track for graduation in May,” Larry Randa, a spokesman for Valley View School District 365U, said. “His loss will be deeply felt by both staff and his fellow students.”

Vera died Aug. 28 while swimming with two other boys, according to Bolingbrook police.

The three were swimming laps

across part of the quarry in the 1400 block of West 135th Street, officials said.

Vera went under the water and did not resurface, according to officials.

## Plane crashes during rush hour in Bolingbrook

A small plane crashed Sept. 25 in a bank parking lot just off Weber Road in Bolingbrook during the afternoon rush hour, killing a Kentucky-based surgeon and his wife.

Witnesses described seeing the plane touch down at nearby Clow International Airport before flying back out, making a turn at low altitude and crashing near the Chase Bank at 262 S. Weber Road.

The victims, Dr. Narayan Venugswamy and his wife Jay Venugswamy, left behind two adult children.

The crash remains under investigation.
