

# SCHOOL CLOSED, BOY DROWNS IN QUARRY

Peter Rollo, 10 years old, the son of Charles Rollo, 4767 St. Louis avenue, yesterday morning fell into an abandoned quarry pond at 4800 Ashland avenue and was drowned. The water is said to be 150 feet deep and efforts to recover the body by exploding dynamite and seining have failed.

The Rollo boy, accompanied by Andrew and George Crouse, 10 and 7 years old, could not go to school on account of the influenza quarantine, so they went fishing. While on a ledge overlooking the hole young Rollo lost his balance and fell. The Crouse boys ran home and told their mother. Policemen and firemen dragged the water. The quarry belongs to August Heman.
