

DROWNS IN QUARRY

Warren Howard, residing at 2730 Washington avenue, was drowned at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon in an abandoned quarry at Spring and Chouteau avenues, when he lost his balance on the rear end of a wagon from which he was shoveling dirt, and fell a hundred feet to the water which fills the quarry's bottom. Police summoned a hook and ladder company and the body was dragged from the pond, which is almost 50 feet deep.
