

## DROWNS IN QUARRY POOL AT ROCHELLE

Rochelle, July 10.—John Highstreet, aged about 25, an ex-soldier, was drowned in the stone quarry about 10:30, Thursday night. In company with Guy Cross he was enjoying the water, though it developed he could not swim, and was last seen by Mr. Cross at the ladder exit to the pool. Mr. Cross was swimming to the raft and heard no outcry. Pedestrians on the bank testified the same.

At the inquest Friday morning a verdict of accidental death by drowning was returned. The body was recovered soon after the accident and a physician called. Rescuers worked for two hours to revive the spark of life, but in vain.
