

## TWO YOUNG WOMEN DROWN

Step Off Ledge Into Hole While  
Wading in Quarry Near Bluffton.

BLUFFTON, Ind., July 19.—While wading yesterday afternoon in an abandoned quarry north of Bluffton, Irene Buckles, age seventeen, and Jennie Conrad, age eighteen, both of Bluffton, were drowned. The young women were on what appeared to be a shallow beach when they stepped over a ledge into a hole. The bodies were recovered after fifteen minutes, and physicians worked for two hours in futile attempts at resuscitation. The mother of Miss Conrad, who was on the bank fishing, saw the accident and summoned bathers from an adjacent pond.
