

BROTHERS DROWN IN QUARRY HOLE

EASTON, Pa., June 11.—Virgil Uhler, 14 years old and his brother, Howard, five, sons of Mr. and Mrs. Stewart Uhler, of Edelmans, a few miles from here were drowned in the quarry hole of the Penn Slate Company, near their home last night. The boys went to the hole to fish and it is supposed the younger fell in and his brother, who was a good swimmer jumped in after him. When they failed to return home for supper their mother went to the quarry hole and found the straw hat of the older son on the bank. After grappling all night the bodies were recovered this morning in sixty feet of water.
