

AUGUSTA BOY DROWNS IN ABANDONED QUARRY

AUGUSTA, April 23.—An eight year old lad, Frank Boswell, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Frank Boswell, of this city, was the first accidental drowning victim of the year here Tuesday, when he fell into the deep waters of an abandoned granite quarry, while playing at fishing with a boy companion about the same age. Young Boswell sank to the bottom of the deep water-filled quarry before the frantic calls of his playmate for assistance could be responded to. Efforts to resuscitate the boy were without avail, tho his body was recovered half an hour later. The victim was a pupil at St. Mary's parochial school.
