

BOYS DROWN IN QUARRY

PHILADELPHIA, May 25.—(A. P.)

—Two boys were drowned today while playing on a raft in the water in an abandoned quarry in West Philadelphia. Only one of the bodies has been recovered. The pool is more than 50 feet deep in some places. Several other youngsters saw the raft capsize but were unable to rescue their playmates.

The boys were Robert J. Bell, Jr., and Charles Brown, each aged 9. They lived near the quarry.
