

## BOY CHASING BUTTERFLY DROWNS IN QUARRY POND

While hunting butterflies yesterday afternoon Elmer Anderson, 2626 Papin street, 17-year-old negro, fell into a quarry pond of the Terminal Railroad Association at Montrose avenue and Atlantic street and was drowned.

He tied a rope around his waist and two companions were lowering him down the 30-foot cliff at the side of the quarry when the rope slipped from the hands of the other boys and he fell into the water.

Members of the Fire Department recovered the body.
