

GREENSBURG BOY FALLS INTO QUARRY POND AND DROWNS

Greensburg, Pa., May 2.—Dick Perry, aged 10, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Perry, Otterman st., slipped and fell into a pond in the Allshouse stone quarry here today while playing with three companions, and was drowned.

The lad was unable to swim. He and his boy companions were playing on a high bank overlooking the quarry when he slipped on the wet bank and plunged into 20 feet of water.

State police and rescuers recovered the boy half an hour later.
