

Columbus Grove Boy Swimmer Drowns In Township Quarry

Columbus Grove, July 28 —

John Robert Johnson, nine-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Johnson, of Columbus Grove, drowned in the abandoned Township stone quarry east of Columbus Grove this afternoon when swimming with playmates. His companions attempted to rescue him but failed.

The body was recovered 40 minutes after the accident by Paul Zellers, Columbus Grove youth, who was called by the boy's companions. Dr. H. H. Sink, Columbus Grove physician, attempted to resuscitate the boy for more than an hour but failed.

In addition to his parents, the boy leaves a brother and a sister. The body was removed to the funeral home of Hartman and son, pending arrangements for the funeral services to be held some time Saturday.
