

# NANTICOKE TOT WADES TO DEATH IN A RESERVOIR

Youngster Drowns When  
She Falls In Deep Water  
Of Colliery Pool

## MINE WORKER HURT

Leona Lunchey, 2, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Lunchey, 223 West Ridge street, Nanticoke, was drowned last evening at 5 in the reservoir at the power plant of the No. 7 colliery of the Susquehanna Collieries Company. The victim, with several companions, was wading along the shore when she accidentally slipped and fell into the deep waters. The body was recovered an hour later by several young men who were summoned by the girl's playmates. The remains were viewed by Deputy Coroner Drew Harter and were removed to the home for burial.

Besides the parents, two sisters, Helen and Josephine, survive.
