

## SISTERS DROWN IN FOSTORIA QUARRY

FOSTORIA, O., June 6.—Two Fostoria girls, who were seeking relief from the heat, were drowned late yesterday afternoon in a deep quarry at the edge of town when they lost their balance and fell off of a ledge into a deep hole.

They were Eileen Sheets, 13, and Lois Sheets, 16, daughters of Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Sheets.

The two, though unable to swim, waded into the water and started ducking each other. Lois slipped and fell into the hole and her sister, in an attempt to reach out for Lois, also lost her balance and sank into the hole.

Their two companions, Viola Moody, 12, and Dorothy Duncan, 16, stood at the edge of the quarry helpless to aid, for they were also unable to swim. Their bodies were recovered in thirty-five minutes and every effort was made to revive them, but to no avail.

Coroner Halford E. Whitacre, of Bowling Green, was called and investigated.
