

Four Year Old Drowns in Quarry

**Menomonee Falls Boy Falls Into
Quarry and Drowns; Body
is Recovered**

Menomonee Falls, Wis.—(U.P.)—Albert Baier, Jr., 4, son of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Baier, drowned in the Harmonn quarry here, Thursday when he fell into 10 feet of water while playing with his cousin, Charles Placek, 4, Chicago.

Charles ran to the Baier home for aid but the boy's body had disappeared when his family reached the quarry. The body was recovered by a deputy sheriff.
