

## Farm Hand Drowns in Quarry

Henry Gottschalk, 50, farm hand, was drowned in an abandoned stone quarry near the Fred Schulte farm, five miles west of Woodville on U. S. Route 20, Tuesday night.

The body was located in the quarry at 2 a. m. Wednesday after search was started when he failed to return to the home of Fred Schulte, where he was employed as a farm hand. His clothing was found on the bank of the quarry and it is believed he was accidentally drowned while in swimming. He was subject to epileptic fits and it is believed he might have been seized with a fit while in the water. He left the Schulte home at 6:30 p. m.

Funeral services were held at 2 p. m. Friday from the Lutheran church at Latchie, Wood county. Rev. Lilje, the pastor, officiated and burial was made in the cemetery north of Gibsonburg. Gottschalk is survived by two brothers, Charles and Fred Gottschalk, of Gibsonburg, and his uncle, Fred Schulte, where he resided.
