

YOUTH DROWNS IN QUARRY POOL

Elmer Kranzusch, 22, Appleton farm hand, drowned in Crystal Lake, popular quarry swimming hole west of Appleton, Sunday afternoon. Kranzusch took one dive and failed to come up, said Lester Schrader, who was bathing with him.

Members of the Winnebago county sheriff's office recovered the body, which was taken to Appleton. A physician said death was due to a heart attack.

Grappling hooks from the local fire department were rushed to the scene of the drowning by Neenah police. The body, however, was not recovered until more than an hour later.
