

Nearly Dies Of Suffocation

Kankakee, Ill., — (UP) — After narrowly escaping death by suffocation, John Carroll, deep sea diver, today abandoned his search for the body of Charles Murphy, negro orchestra player, who drowned in a quarry here Aug. 4.

Last night Carroll became entangled in debris at the bottom of the quarry, lost portions of his equipment, and barely avoided death at the bottom of the pit.

Carroll was sent here last Saturday after Governor Henry Horner responded to an appeal of Murphy's father that an effort be made to recover his son's body. It was reported here that Murphy will appeal to the governor to have the quarry drained.
