

12-YEAR-OLD GIRL DROWNS TRYING TO SAVE SISTER, 6

EMMITSBURG, Md., May 14.—(AP)—A 12-year-old girl gave her life today in a vain attempt to rescue her 6-year-old sister from drowning in an abandoned rock quarry near their home here. Their father recovered the bodies.

Theresa McLaughlin, 6, stepped into deep water while wading in the quarry and went down. Audrey, 12, her sister, went to her aid and both girls drowned.
