

BOYLE YOUTH, 10, DROWNS IN ABANDONED QUARRY

DANVILLE, Ky., June 9.—George Alfred Roach, 10, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Roach, who live near Brumfield in the western section of Boyle county, was drowned about 12:30 o'clock this afternoon when he fell into a deep pool of water in an abandoned rock quarry on the farm of W. E. Crain.

The boy and three companions, Margaret and Oliver Roach, his sister and brother, and Ethel Vaught, were fishing when the tragedy occurred. The victim had caught a fish and was reaching over the bank to lift it from the water when he lost his balance and plunged into the pool.

The body was recovered but efforts to resuscitate the youth failed.
