

Three Drownings Mar Holiday In Eastern Maine

Thomaston, Bar Harbor, and Caribou, Scenes Of Accidents

Three accidental drownings in Eastern Maine marred Memorial Day observances in Bar Harbor, Thomaston, and Caribou and brought to six the state accident toll for the holiday week-end.

The drowning victims were Frank Richards, Jr., 16, Thomaston high school sophomore, who drowned while swimming in an abandoned limerock quarry near his home; Miss Thelma Gray, 17, Bar Harbor high school junior, drowned at Lakewood, a summer resort about two miles from the Hulls Cove home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Irving Gray; and Zadoc Forbes, 55, of Caribou, drowned late Monday afternoon while attempting to swim the Aroostook river.
