

YOUTH DROWNS IN QUARRY NEAR VAN WERT

Howard Shively, 12, of Ridge Township, Drowns Sunday Night — Body Recovered Several Hours Later

Howard E. Shively, 12, of Ridge township, drowned Sunday night in the water of an abandoned stone quarry five miles northeast of Van Wert.

The youth went swimming at about 7:30 and according to his companion sank suddenly without a cry and never appeared. The water was between 20 and 30 feet deep at the point he disappeared from view.

His body was recovered several hours later by members of the Van Wert county sheriff's department and the members of the Van Wert fire department.

The youth was a native of Columbus, and had lived in Ridge township the past four years. Besides his father, he is survived by his step-mother, a brother, Marvin, and a sister, Lucille, both at home.
