## CLINGS TO QUARRY WALL.

After Holding On for Hour And One-Half, Boy Is Rescued.

WILLIAMSPORT, Pa., July 7.—(AP)—After clinging an hour and a half to the side of an abandoned quarry 100 feet above the ground, fifteen-year-old Stuart Kantz Jr. grasped a rope tossed by companions and was hauled over the top to safety last night.

Leaving a picnic group, the boy had attempted to scale the steep, rocky wall. He was within fifteen feet of the top when he found himself stranded—unable to climb higher because of loose shale and unable to get down because of overhanging rocks.

A horrified crowd of seventyfive watched the rescue, effected by four boys who obtained a rope from a farmhouse and reached the top of the quarry wall by a path.
