

CINCINNATIAN'S SON DIES

In Wading Pool In Abandoned
Quarry At Lexington, Ky.

Lexington, Ky., May 18—Ralph Lee Hill, 11 years old, 322 Owsley Avenue, drowned late today when wading in a pond in an abandoned quarry at the east end of Delaware Avenue, just outside the city limits.

The boy, who could not swim, stepped off into a pool 16 feet deep. Playmates notified nearby residents who summoned the Life Squad of the Fire Department. Firemen Waller Scott, Dallas Wade, and Fay Fitch brought the body to the surface with grappling hooks after it had been under water an hour and 10 minutes.

Attempts at artificial respiration were continued at Good Samaritan Hospital for more than an hour before hope of saving the boy's life was abandoned.

The boy was a son of Mrs. Douglas Williams, 322 Owsley Avenue, and Ora Lee Hill, Cincinnati. His grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. A. T. Hill and Mr. and Mrs. Henry Stephens, Montgomery, also survive him.
