

## LAD DROWNS IN AN ABANDONED QUARRY

ORANGE, Va., April 16. (AP) —James Walke, 10-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. L. E. Walke of Orange, was drowned in an abandoned quarry here yesterday afternoon in attempting to rescue a younger brother, William, who had slipped into deep water.

The smaller boy was pulled to safety by a 10-year-old girl, Nancy Camper, who gave the alarm.

It was understood here that the three children were wading at the quarry edge when the accident occurred.

Members of the Orange fire company tried for two hours to revive James Walke after his body had been recovered.
