

Hanover Boy Drowns in Abandoned Quarry Hole

HANOVER, July 16.—While swimming with his two younger brothers in an abandoned quarry hole near here, George L. Brady, Jr., 10, son of Mr. and Mrs. George L. Brady, Hanover, got beyond his depth yesterday afternoon and drowned in forty feet of water. The body was recovered today, and Coroner L. U. Zech, after an investigation, said death was accidental.

George and his brothers, Donald, 7, and Robert, 9, left home early in the afternoon, ostensibly bound for Green Pine Park. Instead they went to the quarry hole. When George cried out for help, the two younger boys were unable to help him, and their cries were unheard because the section is sparsely settled. The pair ran to a tannery some distance away. Workmen reached the quarry too late to be of aid.
