

YOUTH DROWNS IN ABANDONED QUARRY

Kenneth Jollay Had Been
Swimming With Friends.

Kenneth Jollay, 17, of 516 Galbreath Street, drowned last night while swimming with friends in the abandoned, water-filled Kincaid Quarry near Chapman Highway, about a mile from the city limits.

Jollay's body lay at the bottom of the 35 feet of water almost four hours before officers and rivermen found it. Recovery was made by John Learn and Ike Rader.

With Jollay, according to county officers, were the following: David Moran, 18, of Cincinnati; Johnny Kimbrough, 920 Tulip Street; Wanda Austin, 316 Tenth Street; and Frances Maynor, Western Avenue.

The victim had been dressed in women's clothing, the companions told officers, but wore only underwear when he went under during a swim. The rest of his clothing was found on the bank. Jollay went about frequently in Knoxville dressed as a woman, police said.

Kimbrough was taken into custody and turned over to city detectives who had been seeking him for questioning in connection with purse snatching. He was being held in Juvenile Home today. Jollay's body is at Rose's.
